In this event, we will make "TAKIDASHI" (soup kitchen) meals that can be eaten by all local residents, regardless of religion or food culture.

Then we will sample "TAKIDASHI" (soup kitchen) meals together while listening to lectures by disaster nursing volunteers from Pakistan, Nepal, and the Great East Japan Earthquake.

Through this event we will provide an opportunity to think about creating a town where everyone can live peacefully without any concerns of food.
